
# Mission

To provide sustainable livelihood through the provision of health, education and economic safety nets for orphans, teenage parents and their wards to safeguard their future.

# Vision

The over-arching vision of the Foundation is to establish and galvanize a global system for orphans, teenage pregnant mothers and their wards, to live humanely.





#### Criteria

To benefit for support from the Foundation, an applicant must satisfy the following conditions:

1. Be between ages 13-19.

2. Must come from deprived home or community.

- 3. Must hail from or be an indigene of Sirigu or any of its communities.
- 4. Must be willing to further education or learn a vocation.
- 5. Be bonded to be of good behavior.
- 6. Be a Goodwill Ambassador for the Foundation.

### Activities

Apart from providing funding towards the education, health and general wellbeing of beneficiaries, the Foundation will also under programs and projects in line with its objects including:



Religious tolerance and peaceful co-existence.

# Management

A 5-Member Board of Trustee appointed by the Founder, Mr. Roland Agambire, will administer the Foundation. Members of the Board of Trustees shall be made up of 3 women and 2 men who are passionate about humanity, especially deprived children.

# Funding

The operations of the Foundation shall be funded through:

- 1. A GHC 100,000 seed money from its Founder.
- 2. Quarterly inflows from personal earnings of the Founder.
- 3. Donations from the public
